# **CURRENT PROJECTS**

#### ANIMAL WELFARE CONTENT INCUBATOR

H/3 is establishing a content incubator that identifies promising film, television, streaming, digital and other animal-related content, and provides funding to writers, directors and producers to develop, produce, distribute and market their stories globally and across platforms.

H/3's platform serves as a broadly-inclusive clearinghouse for ideas, talent and the creative community to develop, collaborate, fund and promote animal and related environmental content. The clearinghouse and content lab spans stories and messages related to wildlife, agricultural animals and companion animals, as well as the natural environments and habitats on which they (and we) depend.

The H/3 incubator funds leading and promising digital content developers, writers, actors, directors, producers and other creative talent across the spectrum, not just those with prior animal or environmental credits. This platform is designed to have a global reach, in support of H/3's global mission.

### **HUMANE EDUCATION**

H/3 Foundation played a crucial role in empowering children to become active participants in tackling animal welfare problems in Puerto Rico by supporting the Humane Puerto Rico program's section that helps teachers integrate humane education into their curricula. Additionally, specialized training for law enforcement officials, animal control agents, and social workers was provided through the program, which was launched in 2015 as a collaboration between Humane Society of the United States, Humane Society International, and the Government of Puerto Rico.



### **DIGITAL CONTENT**

#### **TOUCAN NATION**

H/3 Foundation, in association with Humane Society International, presented the Prime Time Emmy®-winning film, Toucan Nation, which chronicles the story of Grecia, a toucan in Costa Rica whose abuse led to a national animal welfare campaign, and showcases how the Zooave Animal Refuge Center, school children, and animal rights activists fought for animal welfare legislation. The film highlights the remarkable impact that passionate engagement and motivated advocacy can have in creating a powerful movement.

## TROPHY



H/3 Foundation provided funding for the documentary, Trophy, which premiered at the 2017 Sundance Film Festival and earned an Emmy nomination for Outstanding Nature Documentary at the 40th News and Documentary Emmy Awards. The film highlights the complexities and tensions between wildlife conservation and big-game hunting businesses, offering a thought-provoking exploration of this controversial topic.

### BIRDS OF A FFATHER

Produced in association with H/3 Foundation and Robert Kenner, director of the Oscar-nominated and Emmy-winning film Food, Inc., this heartwarming short film highlights the Serenity Park Sanctuary program, which pairs combat veterans with abandoned, abused, neglected, or relinquished parrots, and showcases how the shared experiences of trauma allow for a profound connection.



### **DIRECT ACTION**

#### **PAWS**

#### NEW MEXICO WILDLIFE CENTER

The H/3 Foundation provided a three-year grant to the New Mexico Wildlife Center in Española to fund a full-time veterinarian and renovate eight animal enclosures, which is a game-changing addition for the center's 1,000 wildlife patients a year. The grant covered the veterinarian's salary and associated professional licensing and certifications, as well as the renovations of the mews and other animal enclosures.
